AGFA Wildlife Trust Fund

Hide Collection Program - This annual program saw hunters donate 550 hides to club depots. We received 24 Moose, 22 Elk and 406 deer hides. Thanks to these efforts the Trust should gain approximately \$2,000. In addition to the major prizes (the rifles) we received additional prizes – one for every 100 hides. Murray Harvey, Vern Murray and Don Kenyon were awarded butchering tools and Randy Fedorak and Jerome Sopczak were awarded belt-mounted holsters containing a hatchet and a hunting knife.

Thanks again to our members who operate Hide Collection Depots. They are Bob Everett, Blaine McGrath, John Hunter, Ian Monaghan, Art Martens, Bill Southam, Robin Denroche and Bryce Chase. Special thanks to Art Beck who arranged for the collection of 50 hides at the landfill site in Hanna.

Shed Antler Program - This past year saw 31 shed antlers turned in, 24 alone by Bob Miller of DeWinton. Sheds are a valuable contribution to the Trust and spring is an ideal time to look for sheds. Our members and friends are urged to make a point of searching for these items that generate much-needed funds with which the Trust buys land for wildlife habitat.
