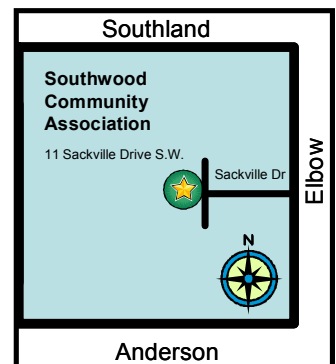

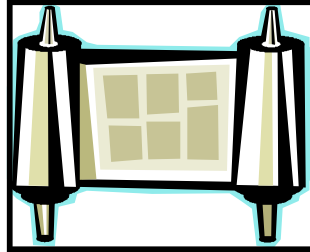
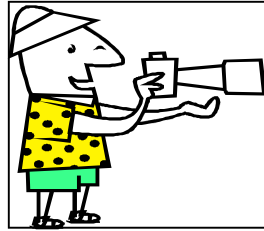

Wildlife Trust Hide Collection ---2006

The Annual Hide Collection Program saw a total of 429 hides donated by hunters to the Trust of which 387 were deer, 28 moose and 14 elk. My personal thanks and those of the Trust go to members who provided collection sites. These were Bob Everett, Blaine McGrath, John Hunter, Robin Denroche, Art Martens and Bill Sotham. The trucker for Halford Hide was particularly thankful to these members who brought the hides they had collected to join those at my house so that he could pick all the hides up at one place. He picked them all up in two trips.

Because we had over four hundred hides we had four prizes (Portable Game Cleaning Kits) for our draw within the main draw for the Rifles, which takes place later this month. The winners of the kits are Brian Hauck, Kelly Wilson, Adam Poncelet and Richard Mercer. I have contacted these people in order to deliver their prizes.

Thanks again to all those who donated hides. We look forward to hearing from you and your friends again next fall. As you know the money raised from the sale of the hides goes to the purchase of land for wildlife habitat.
