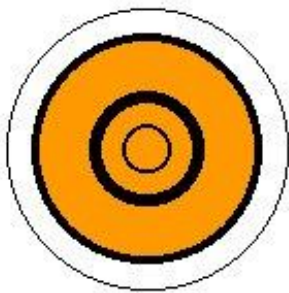
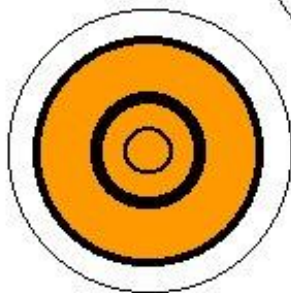
CHOOSE THE APPROPRIATE SIZE RING FOR YOUR EQUIPMENT. The smallest inside ring is not a standard spot, but can be used if the archer is an expert. The next larger ring is the inner ten spot in a FITA target and the next larger size is the ten ring for recurves and compound fingers shooters. The outside ring can be used as a handicap for less experienced shooters.



GAME SUGGESTIONS:

GAME #1 Shoot 15 arrows, 5 at a time. Count number of hits in your class.

GAME #2 Shoot as many arrows as it takes to hit all spots in your class. Shoot from beginning (START) to end (FINISH). X out hits in your class with magic marker. First shooter to hit all spots in his or her class wins.
